

Michael Bloss Biography



Michael Bloss has developed a celebrated reputation for animated performances, sensitive collaborative playing and illuminative coaching. In an enviable career of touring, performing and recording throughout the world, he was the first Canadian to be awarded the designation of *Preisträger* at the International Bach Competition in Leipzig, Germany playing in Bach's own church. J.S. Bach remains his first and best love. Currently, Michael leads the music at Christ's Church Cathedral, Hamilton ON following respected tenures at the Cathedral Church of St. James, Park Congregational Church Grand Rapids and Timothy Eaton Memorial Church, Toronto. Recent appearances include a tour through Germany and Austria with the Chapel Choir of Royal St. George's College, Toronto and recitals in Germany and Denmark. Before the COVID pandemic began, he also served as a CRJ 100/200 Training Captain at Air Canada Express flying to a variety of US destinations and was type rated on the B767 for Air Canada Rouge.
